

KANSAS MARKET WHEAT SHOWS

Dockage: Score Card Points

Dockages shall be weed seeds, weed stems, chaff, straw, grain other than wheat, sand, dirt and any material other than wheat, which can be removed readily from wheat by use of appropriate sieves.

Procedure: Dockage will be determined using official KGIS grading procedures and equipment including the Carter Day dockage machine. Entries analyzed by other means, i.e., by a local elevator or other wheat-handling agency, and subsequently entered in the State Fair will be re-analyzed by a KGIS lab.

Convert percent dockage for each entry to points using the following chart:

.2 % or less = 200 points	1.7 % = 102 points
.3 % = 194 points	1.8 % = 95 points
.4 % = 188 points	1.9 % = 88 points
.5 % = 182 points	2.0 % = 81 points
.6 % = 176 points	2.1 % = 74 points
.7 % = 170 points	2.2 % = 67 points
.8 % = 164 points	2.3 % = 60 points
.9 % = 158 points	2.4 % = 53 points
1.0 % = 151 points	2.5 % = 46 points
1.1 % = 144 points	2.6 % = 39 points
1.2 % = 137 points	2.7 % = 32 points
1.3 % = 130 points	2.8 % = 24 points
1.4 % = 123 points	2.9 % = 16 points
1.5 % = 116 points	3.0 % = 8 points
1.6 % = 109 points	Over 3 % = 0 points

The percent of shrunken and broken kernels likewise will be determined by KGIS procedures and equipment.

Convert percent shrunken and broken kernels to points using the following chart:

Less than .5 percent = 100 points
.6 to 1.0 percent = 90 points
1.1 to 1.5 percent = 80 points
1.6 to 2.0 percent = 70 points
2.1 to 2.5 percent = 60 points
2.6 to 3.0 percent = 50 points
3.1 to 3.5 percent = 40 points
3.6 to 4.0 percent = 30 points
4.1 to 4.5 percent = 20 points
4.6 to 5.0 percent = 10 points
Above 5.1 percent = 0 points
